### An Overview of Community Assessment

Presented by: Denise Eng, Program Manager at Praxis  
International

*Praxis International, Inc. is a nonprofit corporation based out of St. Paul, MN, working toward the elimination of violence in the lives of women and their children.*

The goal of many interagency groups working to end violence against women is to change institutional practices that give rise to poor outcomes for survivors. Community Assessment is a tool used by interdisciplinary groups and advocacy organizations to uncover how specific features, e.g., safety and well-being of victims and accountability of perpetrators, are or are not incorporated into the daily work routines of practitioners. Attendees will learn about the Community Assessment, how to use focus groups and other strategies to centralize the experiences of victims, and how to use text analysis as a tool for finding gaps in the institutional response.
